ESOL AWARDS PRESENTATION

A presentation will be held for students from across the globe who have successfully completed a Wolverhampton course in English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL).

Wolverhampton City Council's Director for Adults and Community, Glen Mason, will hand out the certificates at Pendeford Adult Education Service on Thursday May 24.

A total of 350 students took the most recent ESOL course with Wolverhampton Adult Education Service, studying from four to nine hours a week over 18 weeks.

The students come from many countries including India, Pakistan, Iraq, Afghanistan, Hungary, Poland and Somalia.

They took a range of examinations in February which tested their English language ability in terms of speaking, listening, reading and writing.

Wolverhampton Adult Education Service offers English language classes in many areas of Wolverhampton including Penn Fields, Blakenhall and Whitmore Reans as well as Wolverhampton city centre.

The service also offers home tuition for students unable to attend a class. This popular service is staffed by committed voluntary tutors.
