BRITISH SIGN LANGUAGE (BSL)

You can study British Sign Language (BSL) as a complete beginner and have the opportunity to progress to national qualifications with us.

The introductory course for beginners includes elements of deaf awareness and basic signing skills. If you already have some knowledge of British Sign Language or are a regular signer, you may be ready to join one of our higher-level classes leading to national qualifications at Levels 1 and 2.

We now offer Signing for Wellbeing which is an informal course for those wishing to improve any aspect of their health and wellbeing by having a go at signing in a group.



DIGITAL SKILLS

Improving your digital skills will help you in everyday life and at work. If you want to get a job, get a promotion, go on to higher-level study or just connect with friends, local communities and the world around you then improving your digital skills is a great start.

We have courses available from beginners to Level 3.



ENGLISH

We have English classes for anyone who needs to start with the very first steps in reading and writing and for those who want to read, write and communicate better.

You can work towards qualifications including Functional Skills English from Entry Level up to Level 2 and for English GCSE.

If English is not your first language, you may need to join one of our ESOL classes (see English for Speakers of Other Languages).

LIFE SKILLS (FOR LEARNING DISABILITIES AND/OR LEARNING DIFFICULTIES)

Life Skills Classes are ideal if you are an adult aged 19+ with a learning disability and/or a learning difficulty. The focus is on the preparation for adulthood, independent living and moving you closer to employment. Practical activities could include cooking, arts and crafts, citizenship, English, maths and digital skills. Activities will focus on keeping yourself safe, healthy eating, travel planning, time management, being part of your community and improving your work ready skills.



LEARN SKILLS FOR EVERYDAY LIFE



MATHS

All our teachers are experts in their subject, they have many years' experience of teaching and will make maths fun and easy to understand.

We offer bridging courses across all levels, these are short courses to support you with brushing-up on existing skills before starting Functional Skills or GCSE.

We offer qualifications from Entry Level, Level 1, Level 2 and GCSE.

We now have online Fast Track courses for students who have a secure maths background and are working at Level 2.

If you do not have a GCSE grade 9-4 (A*-C) in Maths your course will be free so you have nothing to lose.

Time will be spent in the classroom and in a short work placement so that you will be ready to move into work.

When it ends, you will have gained skills to help you get a paid job, move to further learning or a Supported Apprenticeship.



CELTA is ideal if you would like a qualification to be able to teach English as a foreign language but have little or no teaching experience. It is the most widely recognised English language qualification in the world and the most often requested by employers.


Learn something fun, meet new people in your local area and learn together for a positive future.

SIGNING FOR WELLBEING

Learning basic signing in a group can be therapeutic. You will meet new people, reduce isolation, improve your confidence and learn how to empathise with those experiencing disability. Activities use hands, face and body to communicate as you learn to express yourself in a way that you might not otherwise.

One of your options may be to apply for an Advanced Learner Loan.

We recommend you apply for your loan as early as possible so that you can join your course on time. You may also be able to get help with your travel resources and childcare costs too.
